

Saint Report Instructions

This is a simple project so don't panic when you hear about it, please!

It requires you to explore which Saint you would like to take as your Confirmation namesake.

You may use your Baptismal name if it is a Roman Catholic Saint's name. For example, my name is Joanne and I was named after Joan of Arc. So I could use my given name again as my Confirmation name. Instead, I choose my mom's name, Ruth (to honor my mom and Saint Ruth). Your Saint has to be a Saint of the Roman Catholic Church.

Now it is time for you to research about your Saint by use of a book or the Internet.

After completing doing your research, you will write two paragraphs in total. The first paragraph will describe your Saint and the second paragraph will elaborate on why you chose that particular Saint for your Confirmation name.

HINT: Usually, students choose the Saint that represents what they characteristically/morally represent or aspire to become. The reason I chose Saint Ruth was because her name was the same as someone in my life that inspired me. Ruth was a wonderful, faith-full daughter in law when her husband died and she remained living with her mother in law and followed the faith of her husband in spite of his death; this was not customary at that time. She served her faith community for the rest of her life and became a model of faith-fullness in her time, ultimately becoming canonized for her patient, loving selflessness to her family and community.
